Governor General Academic Award

Presented to Janelle Roberts

The Governor General's Academic Medal was created by Lord Dufferin, Canada's third Governor General after Confederation

in 1873. This medal is awarded to the student graduating with the highest grade point average. Famous recipients of this medal include Pierre Trudeau, Tommy Douglas and Adrienne Clarkson. The winner of this year's Governor General's Award is Janelle Roberts, who graduated in June with a Grade 11 and 12 grade point average of 95.5%.

UNBC Scholarship

Presented to William Matthew Powley

The UNBC Scholars program recognizes outstanding grade 11 students in northern BC and the Yukon for their academic achievement and encourages them to attend UNBC. The scholarship will take the form of a waiver of full tuition costs and course fees to a maximum of 120 credits (or the number of credits required for a Bachelor's degree).

Students do not apply to be UNBC Scholars. Rather, at the conclusion of the academic year, each highschool in northern BC & Yukon will nominate the one student from their school with the highest grade point average at the end of grade 11 (minimum 80%). Schools are asked to nominate their top student whether or not the student has identified UNBC as the institution of choice for his/her future academic plans. Grade Point Average for Scholars will be calculated from six courses: English 11, Pre-Calculus 11, three other academic courses and one elective. In Grade 11, Matthew Powley had a grade point average of 88.8%
