The Board of Education acknowledges and accepts its responsibility to protect the privacy of employees and students. In fulfilling its responsibilities, the Board is guided by the B.C. Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (FOIPPA) and the School Act.

Regulations

- 1. As required under Section 76.1(a) of the Act, the Board designates the Secretary Treasurer as the official head of the School District for the purposes of the Act.
- 2. As permitted under Section 76.1(b) of the Act, the Board authorizes the Secretary Treasurer, to be responsible for the administration of the Act and to make operational decisions. The Secretary Treasurer is authorized to issue procedures required to support the district's administration of the Act.
- 3. As permitted under Section 76.1(c) of the Act, the Board adopts the schedule of fees as set in Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Regulation, B.C. Reg. 155/2012.
