Once again, we have had evidence of threatening school graffiti at RL Angus.

RCMP members have attended the school, photographed the graffiti, and opened a file. Safer Schools Together, the company that delivers the mandated provincial violence Threat Assessment to schools, has been contacted. The graffiti has been found to be a very low-level form of threat and did not mention any violence that would take place at the school. Therefore, we have been advised that though we must remain vigilant, there is no need to have schools under a "Hold and Secure" or keep students inside.


At R.L. Angus School we will be making a permanent change till the end of the school year to ask students to enter through the front door of the school so that we know students feel safe and secure. Our other schools will also be extra vigilant and limit door access. As reported previously, we are well on the way to identifying critical concerns and completing a review of our schools' entry ways and cameras to develop a greater security plan for each school while still maintaining a warm and welcoming environment. These school plans will be implemented over the summer.
